



The Heron at Pelican Bay

Its owners are from dissimilar backgrounds - law, medicine, academe, business, communications, and more, but they share a deep appreciation for the elegant design, the architectural understatement of the Heron, and the pleasure of living here.

Although a twenty-floor, high-rise condominium, the Heron has only 40 apartments – two per floor. Each offers a sweeping view of the Gulf of Mexico, a view of the water from almost every room, and outside exposure on four sides.

The building is constructed of 6-inch poured concrete walls and floors, and sits on the highest elevation along a three-mile stretch of land and bays that compose Pelican Bay. Because of the respect shown to the protected marine refuge and ecosystem it embraces, it is a model community in Florida.

A healthy life-style is fostered with an exercise room, outdoor spa, two saunas, a tennis court and easy access to the tram and Gulf. The berm walk to the wide sand beaches and restaurants meanders through a mangrove forest that is a nature lovers dream and is home to ducks, owls, and wading birds as well as to frogs, otters and alligators among many other species.

The Community Center offers an outstanding fitness center (available 7-days a week without charge) as well as tennis courts, a fitness spa, masseuse, yoga, and Pilates.

Waterside Shops with its dozens of very high-end boutiques and fine restaurants is a half-mile walk away. So is the Philharmonic Center for the Arts, and the Naples Museum of Art. There is ample free parking as well as valets for the even more indulgent.
